The City of Pembroke Pines Great Yards Award

Pembroke Pines, FL (November 6, 2023) -- The City of Pembroke Pines will once again be recognizing yards with the Natalie Belmonte Great Yards Award (NBGYA), however a few changes have been made. The Great Yards Award contest will have monthly nominations by each District, and an Awarding Cycle which will run throughout the entire year starting in January 2024. This award was designed to promote quality, Florida-friendly landscaping within the City of Pembroke Pines and inspire others to participate.

Contest Details

This award was created in memory of Natalie Belmonte, a well-known resident, businesswoman, and nature-lover, who tragically lost her life in July of 2011. This award helps capture the beauty of nurturing a butterfly garden and the love Natalie had for gardening, as well as recognizes the hard work that each resident puts into maintaining a beautiful front yard that displays Florida-friendly landscape practices.

Applications

Applications must be received by the 1st of the selection month the resident is applying for. If an application is submitted past the date allowed for that district a resubmittal will be required during the month allowed.


