City of Pembroke Pines Interactive Wall Public Art Project

Pembroke Pines, FL (March 4, 2024) – Applications now being accepted -- The City of Pembroke Pines is seeking an artist or team to design, fabricate, and install site specific interactive artwork for attachment to an exterior wall at the Charles F. Dodge City Center, located at 601 City Center Way. The artwork should be visually appealing and include an interactive component to actively engage the building's visitors. **The submission deadline is Thursday, April 18, 2024.**

Project Details

The City of Pembroke Pines is interested in commissioning a dynamic exterior artwork that creates a sense of place, creatively enhances the exterior wall, actively engages the visitors of the building, and compliments the surrounding environment.

The all-inclusive budget for the project is \$15,000 which includes but is not limited to artist fees, consultants, fabrication, storage, transportation, installation, permits and insurance provisions. Shortlisted artists must submit a detailed budget list.

Artist Selection

Professional artists, eighteen years of age or older, residing in Broward, Miami-Dade, or Palm Beach counties with strong experience in executing their ideas through to completion, meeting deadlines, and budgets are encouraged to apply. Applicants should demonstrate through their submission materials that they have the skills and experience to successfully complete a public art project.

Each shortlisted artist will receive information about the project and have a minimum of one month to prepare a preliminary design and will be paid an honorarium of \$500 for the proposal.
