What are some causes of unwanted alarms?

1. Cooking Incidents.
2. Faulty Smoke Alarms
3. Improper Location of Smoke Alarms

Did you know ?

False Alarms:

- Take police and firefighters away from real emergencies.
- Result in considerable expense to the public.
- Can jeopardize the safety of the Fire Department who must respond to the false alarm in a timely matter.

There are several steps to prevent false alarms

1. Do not locate smoke alarms in the kitchen. Cooking is one of the leading causes of unwanted smoke alarms.
2. Keep smoke alarms away from steam that may come from bathrooms, kitchen equipment or other appliances.
3. A chirping smoke alarm means the battery is weak and needs to be replaced.
4. Keep the detectors clean.
5. Have your security company check and service the system regularly.
