NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, The Pembroke Pines Police Department is requesting public comment and input on the 2019 Edward Byrne Justice Assistance Local Solicitation Grant program from residents of Pembroke Pines, for a period of (30) days. The Edward Byrne Justice Assistance Grant program is a formula grant to municipalities based on crime statistics. The grant funds are allocated by the Florida Department of Law Enforcement and can be used for a variety of law enforcement programs and activities.

Proposed Distribution, The Pembroke Pines Police Department is eligible to receive \$23,436.00 in grant funding through the 2019 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) program (Application #BJA-2019-15141) from the U.S. Department of Justice. The Pembroke Pines Police Department will utilize the funds to purchase General Equipment for sworn police officers and on National Incident Based Reporting System (NIBRS) compliance related training for administrative personnel.
